Presentation Synopsis: Set the stage. Provide an overview of the topic.

Learning Objectives: Write two or three that tie back to your synopsis.

- Please use measurable verbs.
 - Common verbs that can be used to review, discuss, apply, classify, diagram, employ, recommend.

Take-away: (In some cases, this may be what you learned)

• A brief statement of how your presentation will impact the attendees in terms of: competence (ability), performance (competence put into "action"), or patient outcomes (if applicable).
